- Composed, "The Four Seasons"



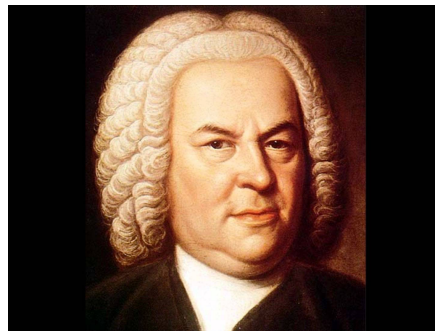
